Ronald McDonald House South East Queensland (RMH SEQ) provides accommodation and support services for seriously ill children and their families who live more than 50km from the treating hospital in Brisbane. Our Ronald McDonald Houses help to preserve the family unit in the midst of physical, emotional and financial stress. It also gives parents the chance to draw hope and comfort from other families in similar situations, while being supported by dedicated and friendly staff and volunteers. We aim to provide a 'home away from home' for all of our guests

RMH SEQ currently has two houses in Brisbane; one at Herston beside the Royal Brisbane & Women's Hospital and one at South Brisbane near the Lady Cilento Children's Hospital (LCCH) and Mater Mothers Hospital. The organisation also has Family Rooms located inside the Gold Coast University Hospital and other services in the LCCH. Our services within the LCCH also extend to 10 emergency overnight accommodation rooms.
