Tsai Chin's legend began with a singing competition during her 1st year in college. At that time, singing school ballads with a guitar was very popular. Through that competition, she found her favourite guitar and started on her successful music career. She reached her prime in the 80s, picking up numerous music awards across Asia, Europe and USA. Tsai has released 41 albums and is widely popular throughout the Chinese world.
