Food Fantasy set to transform to Harvest Buffet

The Gold Coast's best-known buffet is set for a major transformation with Food Fantasy at The Star Gold Coast to close its doors following breakfast from July 3 to undergo a complete redesign and expansion.

Harvest Buffet will see capacity increase by more than 100 to approximately 500 seats, as well as the construction of a new state-of-the-art kitchen and a new entrance allowing for a more seamless entry into the popular restaurant.

A feast for the senses, Harvest Buffet will celebrate Australia's finest seasonal produce including a carvery station, a sumptuous seafood buffet, and a decadent dessert display featuring a custom designed chocolate fountain.

New dessert menu at Cucina Vivo

Italian favourite Cucina Vivo has overhauled its dessert menu, adding a contemporary twist to some traditional dishes.

The Chocolate Panna Cotta has been labelled as a 'chocolate lovers dessert'. Dark chocolate mousse is dehydrated overnight with the final crispy result light and airy (and also gluten free!) Prior to being served it is drizzled in more dark chocolate, and once at the table it is finished with the pouring of dark chocolate sauce swirled with frothy milk.

The Pistachio and Olive Oil cake proves itself to be a nutty yet surprisingly refreshing dessert. Made with a pistachio cream on the base, extra virgin olive oil cake, pistachio tuile, crème fraiche sorbet, and pistachio glass, fresh pistachios are then microplaned over the dish to finish.

Touted as the masterpiece of the new menu is The Amalfi Pearl. The dessert is a homage to Pastry Chef Salvatore De Riso who was the first pastry chef from the south of Italy to be admitted into the prestigious Academy of Italian Master Pastry Chefs. He has a pastry shop in the town of Minori on the Amalfi Coast, with one of his most famous creations a pear and ricotta cake featuring layers of hazelnut sponge, ricotta cream and pear. Cucina Vivo's Amalfi Pearl, created by assistant sous chef Tammy Cole, was inspired by this and on the plate, the dessert represents a pearl on the Amalfi Coast, surrounded by a bowl of rocks and moss (green sponge) to represent the rocky coast. The pearl consists of chocolate ricotta cake, Frangelico foam, pear sorbet, pear compote and roasted hazelnuts all encased in a white chocolate sphere, sprayed with a shimmer finish. Dry ice poured at the table completes the dish, reminiscent of mist coming off the water in the early hours of the morning.

Grab a blanket, settle back under the heater with friends and enjoy sunset views of the sweeping city skyline and pool. The perfect location for a pre- or post- dinner drink.

Truffle Month (coming in July)

Truffle season will begin at The Star Gold Coast this July with signature restaurants including Cucina Vivo, Kiyomi, Garden Kitchen & Bar and Nineteen at The Star serving up the rare treats. Traditional Italian favourite Cucina Vivo will offer a rotating menu which will feature decadent truffle dishes across its entrée, pasta, main and dessert menus. Cutting-edge Japanese restaurant Kiyomi will also offer a rotating menu which will highlight the luxurious ingredient by including fresh sliced truffles on all of the special menu items. Garden Kitchen & Bar's special dishes will be on a



one-week rotation across the month, with the Oakey Angus Reserve Beef Tartare served with shavings of Tasmanian truffle, Roma tomato relish and peppered grissini sure to be highlight. Nineteen at The Star is sure to excite foodies with their dish of truffle risotto made with aged risotto rice (carnaroli) and served with shaved black truffle and chive oil. Guests will be able to indulge in the heavenly taste of these rare delights for as long as they remain in season.
